Varsity Football Coach Southside High School Job Description, 01/2010

Position Summary/Qualifications:

Fully certified teacher/paraprofessional with a minimum of 5 years experience in football coaching. This person should have extensive knowledge and experience in planning, organizing and supervising the school football program—all levels. As the leader of a staff of coaches of a major revenue producing sport in a school, this person should display leadership skills that will be conducive to high levels of productivity. Proven decision making skills and a track record of initiative, effort and commitment to young people and education is a must. Above all, this coach should be a "people person" and indicate, through his actions, a personality that is conducive to positive interaction with students, staff and parents.

The varsity football coach is responsible for initiating various aspects of the football program, such as player development, eligibility requirements, scheduling opponents, training and coaching team members.

The varsity football coach is required to abide by the rules and regulations established by Southside High School, the South Carolina High School League and the Code of Ethics for Coaches in the Greenville County Schools.

Responsibilities:

- 🌻 Represent Southside High School and the football program in a professional manner.
- 🌻 Schedule games with approval of the Athletic Director.
- 🌻 Directly responsible for the welfare and safety of all athletes in the program. Teaching the fundamentals of physical conditioning and the game of football are critical in this responsibility. The coach and his/her staff should be well-versed in care and prevention of athletic injuries.
- 🌻 Coordinates the football program and is responsible for leading, managing and guiding his staff of assistant coaches. Organizes and schedules practice sessions.
- 🌻 Stays up-to-date in the current knowledge and trends in his sport. The methods and techniques that are used and taught should indicate an understanding and interest in young people.

- 🌻 Is directly responsible for the safety, cleanliness, care and maintenance of the locker rooms, facilities, bleachers, equipment, and courts.
- 🌻 Makes sure that all of the participants are eligible—physical exams and insurance are carefully recorded and the academic performance is monitored and emphasized.
- 🌻 Works with the total athletic program. Has a good rapport with the faculty and the athletic staff. He should emphasize student participation in other sports and activities. At no time should any coach encourage players to specialize unless the athletic director and coaches of the other sports are notified and it is in the best interest and welfare of the student involved.
- 🌻 Is responsible for maintaining proper conduct and behavior of his athletes.
- 🌻 Is directly responsible for the inventory of uniforms and equipment at the end of the season and the proper storage thereof.

Terms of Extra Duty Assignment:

Annual assignment by the principal with a stipend based on the Supplementary Salary Scale for Athletics. The principal, in his/her discretion, may terminate this assignment at any time, for any reason, with no right of recourse by the coach. Your stipend for this school year is:
